THE BUYER : The highest bidder shall be the buyer at the "hammer price" and any disputes shall be settled at the auctioneers absolute discretion. Every bidder shall be deemed to act as principal unless there is in force a written acknowledgment by the ISC that he acts as an agent on behalf of a named principal. **All buyers will be members of the ISC.**
LIABILITY : All lots are sold as *genuine* unless otherwise stated and have been correctly described in the sale catalogue. A purchaser may be liberty to reject any lot if they (i) give written notice of their intention to question the genuineness of an item, in the UK within 7 days and overseas 14 days from the date of the sale, (ii) provides evidence that the lot was not genuine or incorrectly described, (iii) returns the item to the auctioneer within 30 days of the sale **IN THE SAME CONDITION AS IT WAS AT THE TIME OF PURCHASE.** The onus is on the purchaser to show the lot is not genuine or incorrectly described. The inability of an expert to express a definite opinion shall serve to discharge the onus onto the purchaser and cause a rejection of any contention.

POSTING : All items under a value of £200 will be sent in the UK by 1st class post, and to everywhere else by international recorded delivery, **unless** the buyer expresses an alternative. Items over £200 will be sent by registered post. If the total of lots purchased exceeds £200 then these will be broken down such that no package sent will exceed a value of £200. All postage and packaging costs will be borne by the purchaser.

STAMP PAPERS : Papers will be, wherever possible, sent unfolded and flat. Such packages will attract higher postage costs and the purchaser should be aware of this when casting a bid.

BUYERS PREMIUM : There will be 5% charge levied on all purchases.

PAYMENTS : No lots will be dispatched until full payment has been received. All payments are due immediately but a concession of 28 days from the date of the invoice is given to allow for arrangements for payment to be made. After this date an additional premium of GBP 5 will be added to the account to cover the cost of administrative/storage fees and sending a single reminder letter, further premiums of GBP 5 will be added each time a reminder letter is sent until the account is cleared. Failure to clear an account within 56 days of the date of the original invoice will cause the lots to be offered to the under bidders. Future bids from members who have defaulted on payment will only be acceptable if a pre-payment arrangement is agreed and any outstanding items in their account cleared.

The following 10 lots, 324 to 334, from the CALCUTTA SMALL CAUSE COURT, are of great rarity, not the stamps alone, although they are quite scarce but the fact these stamps are found on piece: this rarity is reflected in the opening estimates. These pieces were "rescued" from the Court Archives and some were found "bound" together in the record books, the necessary information as which book and date inserted are part of the information required by the court process. Whilst these court documents are incomplete, *no complete documents have been seen or recorded*, all have the provenance of being ex Mr Wilmot Corfield's collection...
